for Parents



RESPECT

- Mute Mic.
- Make the time to be on time, commit, and come prepared.
- Find a quiet space.
- Make sure to eat before the meeting.



EXCELLENCE

- Turn on video. It allows for others to see and acknowledge you.
- Stage your video area to avoid distractions and interruptions.
- Wear presentable attire for the virtual gathering.
- Type out your full first and last name.



COMMUNITY

- Demonstrate active listening.
- Be an active participant.
- Remove any distractions (cell phone, TV, etc.).



STEWARDSHIP

- Use headphones if you have them.
- Use the chat to alert the facilitator/teacher when you have an issue.
- Use features to communicate- Raised hand, thumbs up, or clap.
- Stare into the camera lens to demonstrate eye contact.
